ANSWERS FROM UMPY

A1. If a jack is moved by a bowl during play it is dead if:

(1) It passes over the face of the bank. (2) Passes completely outside a side boundary of the rink of play. (3) comes to rest in a hollow of the face of the bank; or (4) comes to rest t a distance of less than 20 metres, as measured in a straight line, from the centre of the mat line to the nearest point of the jack.

A2. The skip of team "B" puts the bowl back to its former position. This means that the person replacing the bowl in this way must decide where that position is. If the person cannot accurately identify the former position, they must put the bowl as near as possible to its former position. Same applies in the event the jack is moved by the measuring equipment during the measuring process.

A3. The jack should be returned for the opposing lead to place the mat and to re-deliver the jack, have it centre, but they do not play first.

A4. The mat must be moved and straightened onto the centre line.
